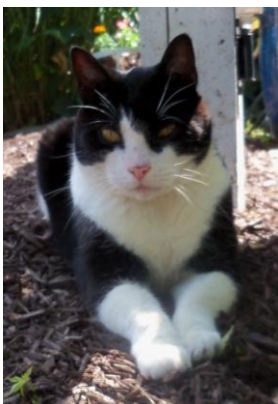


The Book Barn Cat Spotting Guide

Although most of our cats love to be petted and want to play with you, please do NOT try to pick up or carry them. The Book Barn is home to these cats; please recognize that (just like you) sometimes they need a break and just want to be left alone. To that end, please do NOT chase the cats and let them come and go as they please. Additionally, please remember that their fur makes them much more sensitive to heat.



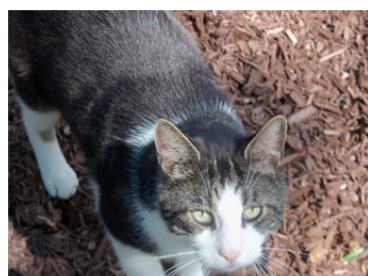
Jake: This black and white big boy has a lot of attitude. He may look well behaved, but he is renowned for his death glare and for his mercurial mood swings. Please do not touch Jake because he tends to bite and scratch. Deep down Jake is a good cat (he's just misunderstood). Jake is usually found sleeping at the buying station or in the Main Barn.



Tiger: This orange and white striped cat is one of the oldest cats we have. He was born on the property and is quite a sweetie. He's been known to defend the other cats against predators and once played Momma to a litter of abandoned kittens. Feel free to pet him, but please be careful of his hips; he was once hit by a car and this area is still sensitive. Tiger can usually be found sleeping near the buying station or near the Main Barn.



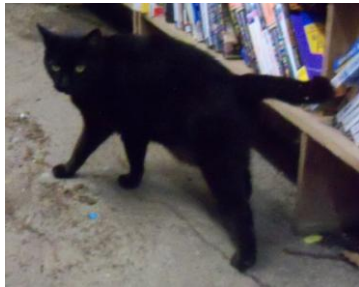
Mao: This small beauty likes to escort visitors to the Book Barn around the property. One of Mao's unique features is her disproportionately short tail (of which she is very proud).



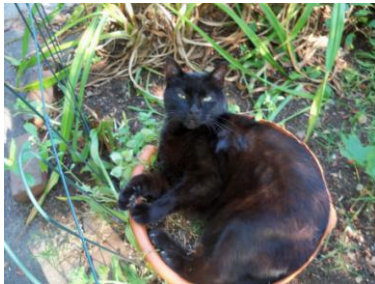
Evinrude: This large and regal cat is a fan-favorite and with his beautiful green eyes and shiny coat it's easy to see why. He has a very sweet temperament so feel free to pet him. He is often found napping in the gardens or in the Main Barn.



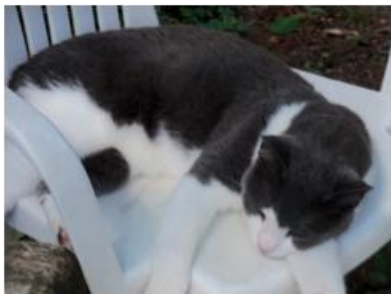
Lucky: This black kitty may be small, but she is the Queen of the cats. Lucky can usually be spotted around the Haunted.



Spookie: This black kitty continually looks as though something has just frightened him. Whenever he gets spooked (which happens often and usually for no apparent reason) his eyes look enormous. Counterintuitively, he can often be found in Hades, as well as around the Main Barn.



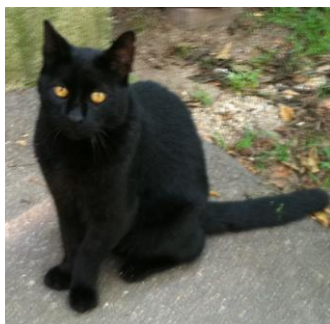
Frankie: This black cat was named after Frank Sinatra because of his tendency to croon. He likes to meow all day long to anyone who will listen. Frankie can be found most often near the buying station.



Jack: This grey and white cat is named after Captain Jack Sparrow from the Pirates of the Caribbean movies. When he was a kitten he used to walk around with a swagger just like everyone's favorite pirate. This little guy has lots of energy and can be found all around the Book Barn.



Tabic: This tabby cat was also born on the property. Although he is very sweet and loving, he is best known for being skittish and finding the best hiding places. Sometimes he can be found around the Main Barn or at the buying tables.



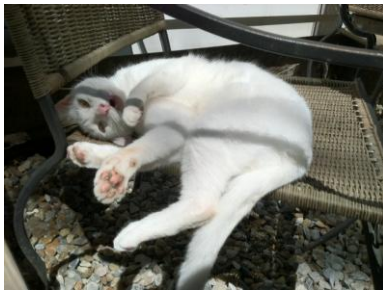
Chip: This black kitty with burnt sienna eyes was also born on the property. He loves attention and sometimes even likes to suck on your clothes. Be careful if you let him suck on you though because he really drools! Chip can usually be found near the Haunted or the Annex.



Tater: Tater likes to hang out around the Haunted in the play area. He has very soft, thick, fluffy fur. He is a fairly big cat but he is a little timid.



Blanche: This surly tabby cat may look young because of her size, but she is actually 16 years old. She was abandoned on our doorstep taped in a cardboard box in 94 degree heat. With only three teeth left, she is very discerning about whom she allows to touch her. Please do not play with this cat because she has been known to bite without warning. Blanche likes to hang out around the buying station or in a chair next to the register in the Main Barn.



Speck: This little guy gets his name from the gray spots that used to be on his forehead. Now he is all white except for the dirt he invariably has on his face. Speck is also called "Boogey" because his nose gets so dirty from playing that he looks like he has boogers. Speck likes to play all over the Book Barn, so look carefully!
